

Is Your House Haunted? Checklist

This list is a reminder of things to check when investigating a *possibly* haunted home or business. Note results and readings with each list item, or on the back of this sheet.

- Carbon monoxide levels okay?
- Residents keep a diary of ghostly phenomena
- Triggers at site: Ouija boards, unusual religious displays, haunted objects?
- EMF check - baseline, elevated EMF, or anomalous spikes
- Floors level?
- Stairs level? Stair rails, too?
- Windows & doors correctly hung? Latches secure?
- Signs of mold or mildew? Household allergies?
- Evidence of animals in walls, ceilings, attic, basement, crawlspace?
- Plumbing, heating, and a/c noises
- Drafts (candle check)
- Hot spots, cold spots
- Vibrations (traffic, trains, air traffic, nearby music, or other)
- Underground streams/springs (geological maps)
- Magnetic fluctuations around site (survey property)
- Reactions of pets? (note where, when)
- Poltergeist possibilities? Spiritual concerns?
